TERMINATION OF FIRE SEASON

Effective Wednesday, 12:01 a.m., PDT, October 21 2015, fire season restrictions will be lifted on lands protected by Walker Range Fire Patrol in northern Klamath and Lake Counties.

We urge landowners to use precautions when burning. The longer term weather is still uncertain and you could be liable for any damages caused by your burning activities.

As a reminder, November 7, 2015, is the North Klamath County free dump day at the Crescent and Chemult Landfills. Stumps, needles, pinecones, leaves and other outdoor material can be dumped for free. No household garbage, appliances or commercial dumping of stumps allowed.

If you live in Klamath County, please take advantage of this event.

Commercial Land Owners:

Commercial slash pile burning will not be allowed until after sometime in mid-November. If you plan on burning commercial slash piles you will need to fill out a burn permit through our office and follow smoke management instructions. Contact the office for further updates as mid-November nears.
